Shiogama Terminal Participates in Sendai Port Cleanup

The Shiogama terminal (Shiogama City, Miyagi; manager: Tsutomu Uramoto) of Tonengeneral Sekiyu K.K. (head office: Minato-ku, Tokyo; representative: Jun Mutoh) took part in a cleanup effort held by the Sendai Shiogama Port and Harbor Office on July 13.

Designated areas, including the coastal road and wharves, were divided among the participants, comprising members of 38 local businesses, who spent about one hour on the cleanup. Sendai Port is a beautiful harbor located adjacent to Matsushima, an area where the scenery is considered to be among the three most beautiful in Japan. The 2011 Great East Japan Earthquake caused sedimentation around the wharves in Sendai Port and an increase in the amount of refuse that washes ashore.
