Shimizu Terminal Participates in Operation Cleanup -Okitsu River

Employees of the Shimizu terminal (Shimizu-ku, Shizuoka City, Shizuoka; manager: Toshihiko Okamoto) of TonenGeneral Sekiyu K.K. (head office: Minato-ku, Tokyo; representative: Jun Mutoh) participated in the Operation Cleanup - Okitsu River initiative, held jointly by the Okitsu River Maintenance Association and Shizuoka City, on September 3. The purpose of the initiative is to maintain the water quality of the Okitsu River, an important waterway and water source for Shimizu-ku in Shizuoka City, and to preserve the natural beauty of the surrounding area. The cleanup, held each year in September, is implemented in 10 locations along the river, including the riverbed from the estuary to the upper reaches of the river, campgrounds, and swimming areas. Around 1,000 people participate in the event each year.
