Miyazaki Terminal Participates in Joint Firefighting Drill

A joint firefighting drill was held by the city of Miyazaki at the Miyazaki terminal (Miyazaki City, Miyazaki; manager: Seiji Kondo) of TonenGeneral Sekiyu K.K. ("TonenGeneral"; head office: Minato-ku, Tokyo; representative: Jun Mutoh) on October 20. In addition to terminal staff, 36 participants from the local fire department, fire brigades, tank truck transport companies and other organizations took part in the drill, which was based on a scenario involving pipe leaks, flash fires and tank truck fires resulting from an inland earthquake in Oita prefecture. During the drill, participants took part in first response exercises for the terminal (reporting, operation of fire extinguishers, rescue of injured drivers), after which participants from the Miyazaki City Minami Fire Department practiced rescue operations on tanks and firefighting from ladder trucks and chemical fire trucks.
