Kawasaki Refinery Participates in 'Tonomachi-Yako Operation Clean' Community Cleanup Activity

The Kawasaki refinery (Kawasaki-ku, Kawasaki City, Kanagawa; refinery manager: Fumito Fujii) of TonenGeneral Sekiyu K.K. (head office: Minato-ku, Tokyo; representative: Jun Mutoh) participated in Tonomachi-Yako Operation Clean, held by Kawasaki City on November 28, as part of its social contribution activities.

In response to calls for volunteers from Kawasaki City, more than 1200 volunteers from 25 organizations and companies in the Kawasaki City coastal area took part in the initiative, which has become a major event in the local community.

Thirty-three employees from the refinery participated in the activity, collecting trash from the roads adjacent to Keikyu Kojima Shinden Station, which they use on their daily commutes.
