TonenGeneral Sekiyu K.K. Shimizu Terminal Holds Extracurricular Activities for Local Elementary School Students

TonenGeneral Sekiyu K.K. (head office: Minato-ku, Tokyo; president: Jun Mutoh) held extracurricular activities at its Shimizu terminal (Shimizu-ku, Shizuoka; manager: Toshihiko Okamoto) for three classes fifth-grade classes comprising 99 students of nearby Sodeshi Elementary School on November 1, 13 and 15.

This initiative, the first of its kind at Shimizu Terminal, consisted of a 2-hour session of classroom study, observation and practice. The first hour was entitled “Let’s Learn About Oil!” and the second “Let’s Observe Disaster Response Activities!”. After viewing videos and actual oil samples to learn about refining processes from raw materials to finished products, the students observed a fire drill with a water-spraying fire truck and gained hands-on experience using foam fire extinguishers.

The classroom sessions elicited comments of interest and surprise from the students, such as “Why does oil burn?”, “How are oil products made?” and “Plastic and clothes are made from oil?”. In addition, by observing the fire drills, the students also gained an understanding of the terminal’s disaster prevention framework for maintaining the safety of the local community
