Streamlining of TG Group Capital Relationships

TonenGeneral Sekiyu K.K. (head office: Minato-ku, Tokyo; president: Jun Mutoh; "TonenGeneral" herein) has passed a resolution for the dissolution of its consolidated subsidiary MOC Marketing G.K. ("MOC Marketing" herein) effective June 30, 2015, and for the purchase of all shares of Kyokuto Petroleum Industries, Ltd. ("Kyokuto Petroleum Industries" herein) from TonenGeneral consolidated subsidiary EMG Marketing Godo Kaisha ("EMG Marketing" herein) effective July 1, 2015, followed by an absorption-type merger of Kyokuto Petroleum Industries into TonenGeneral, also effective July 1, 2015.

Since the acquisition of interest of the former Mitsui Oil Co., Ltd. (currently MOC Marketing) on February 4, 2014, TonenGeneral has gradually integrated MOC Marketing and Kyokuto Petroleum Industries, in which MOC Marketing has a 50% stake, into the TonenGeneral Group. With the completion of the integration of all MOC Marketing businesses and assets, the above resolution is considered appropriate.

This will help to streamline capital relationships within the TG Group and increase the efficiency of our operations.
